The Consumers' Foundation said people suffering from joint pain should avoid becoming over-reliant on the dietary supplement glucosamine, which studies have shown to be ineffective in curing osteoarthritis. Supplements of glucosamine, which usually come in capsules or pills, typically claim to assuage sore joints and prevent cartilage degeneration, with some even claiming they can strengthen joints and bones. Although the amino sugar is not categorized as medicine and suppliers are therefore prohibited from advertising its supposed medicinal benefits, glucosamine products such as Move Free are very popular in Taiwan among people suffering from joint pain. Citing medical research published in the New England Journal of Medicine, the watchdog said glucosamine was not a panacea for people suffering from osteoarthritis. "Although Glucosamine has been shown to relieve pain from inflammation, it should only be taken when the person is in pain," Sun Yat-sen Cancer Center vice president Hsieh Yen-yao said. "It does not cure osteoarthritis." Hsieh said the study showed that a small group of participants with moderate to severe pain showed significant relief when using glucosamine, but that the dietary supplement was ineffective against minor pain or pain resulting from factors not related to inflammation. "Glucosamine has not been demonstrated to prevent or cure any disease," he said, adding that people with severe joint pain can take glucosamine to relieve the pain, but should immediately stop taking it when the symptoms disappear. People with no joint pain should also refrain from taking the supplement and should disregard claims that it will protect the knees or make

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bones stronger, he said. Other common misconceptions include claims that the supplement helps prevent osteoporosis, provides a source of calcium during menopause or enhances performance during sports or physical labor, none of which have scientific basis, the foundation said. For people suffering from osteoarthritis, Hsieh said eating broccoli and avoiding activities that strain the joints, such as heavy lifting, climbing or descending stairs, were better remedies. People who are overweight should also try to lose weight to relieve stress on the joints.

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<p>Children in Taiwan have an increased chance of showing language development delay if they are raised listening to broken Mandarin spoken by a foreign-born parent who has trouble with the language. Chao Wun-tsong, a speech specialist and language pathologist, said that while a bilingual environment is beneficial, strong accents and different pronunciations of the same word in a language system could cause confusion and lead to language development delay. Foreign-born mothers who have recently immigrated to Taiwan are so eager to integrate their preschool-age children into society that they often give instructions to their children in Mandarin, rather than in their own mother tongue, such as Vietnamese, said Chao, who works at Puli Christian Hospital in Nantou County. "I encourage foreign spouses to speak to their children in their mother tongue rather than in a language they are having a hard time grasping," Chao said. Mandarin is a tonal language in which the meaning of a word is easily changed by a minor shift in tone, and children could have a problem developing a system for a word whose pronunciation is different when used by their grandparents, father and mother. He cited a case where a three-year-old girl was brought in for early intervention because she was extremely quiet and spoke only in short phrases. "The girl had no problem with her hearing or comprehension, but we found her Indonesian mother speaking to her in Mandarin with a strong accent." Suspecting this was the cause of the girl's development delay, Chao suggested sending her to kindergarten where she could interact more with native Mandarin speakers. "Within half a year, the child became normal," he said. Out of every 100 children in Taiwan, an estimated six to eight of them suffer from development delays, noting that the number of reported cases has risen recently because of the improved awareness of parents and their ability to detect the condition at an early stage. Although the causes of language development delay could be social, environmental or physical, and are often unpreventable, early intervention is believed to improve minor conditions and reduce long-term social and medical costs. The Bureau of Health Promotion has set up 35 development delay evaluation centers across the country, and parents are encouraged to seek help as soon as they see warning signs.</p> <p>() 46.
